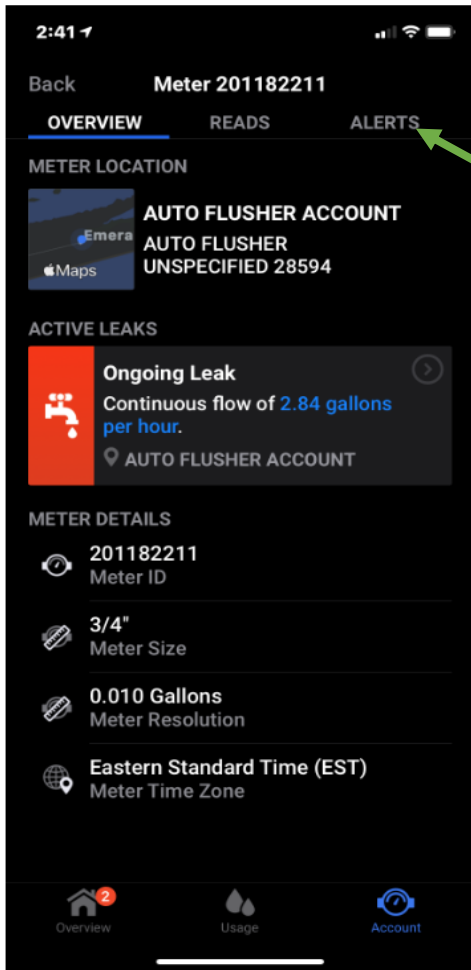
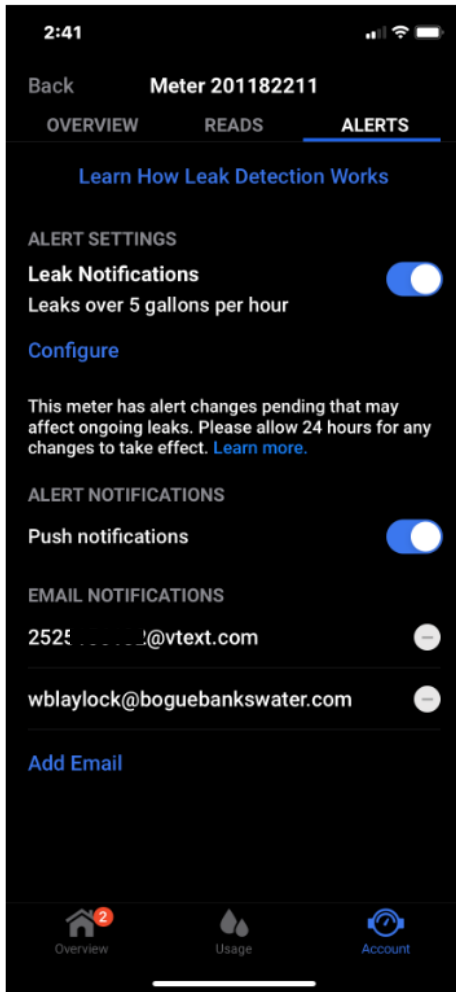


Setting leak alerts with
